Voter ID: Despite widespread objections from the Electoral Commission and Councillors, including me, the Government has decided to require photo identification at the polling stations on Thursday 4th May. Fraud in person at the polling station is very rare. Nevertheless, unless you have a postal vote you will need to bring photo ID on polling day.
